
Follow these steps to build your primary and secondary drivers.





To link a secondary driver to multiple primary drivers, click on the pin symbol found on the left of the driver box.






To link a secondary driver to multiple primary drivers, click on the pin symbol found on the left of the driver box.

This will grey out all the boxes apart from the secondary driver you are trying to link.





Only the primary drivers you can link to will have the pin next to it.









If you want to export your driver diagram, click on the “Export” button.






If you want to export your driver diagram, click on the “Export” button.
