

# Random Word as Provocation

---

## Random Word:

- We use a random word (noun) to provide a totally new starting point outside the mainstream pattern.
- Then, the mind can move forward to try to connect the random word (or an extracted principle or broad direction) to the subject.
- This occurs naturally because of the tendency of the mind to form patterns.

# Provocation Process

1. *Focus: Clarify the problem - state the focus*
2. List the things you already know and the ideas you have about the focus area
3. Form a provocation (we are going to use Random Word method)
4. Generate new ideas; use movement to develop the ideas.

# An example

---

We want to increase customer feedback in our hotel

Random word = RADAR

Characteristic of radar -> Reflection  
Idea = feedback form on mirror

Characteristic of radar -> Dish  
Idea = discount on meal in the restaurant
